Richard D. "Dick" Sherman, age 96 of Cambridge, went to his Heavenly Home on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 in the care of Hospice of Genesis. He was born in Battle Creek, Michigan on December 9, 1924 a son of the late H.C. Sherman and E. L. (Brackenberry) Sherman.

He was a graduate of Brown High School. Dick was drafted into the U.S. Navy in 1945. He was a charter member of the Giffin Park Church in St. Clairsville. He had been the president of Cambridge Dairy Company, co owner of the Floridian Motel in St. Clairsville, worked at Consolidated Coal Company and also at Muskingum Mining Company in Dresden.
