Albert T. Mueser, age 67 of Cambridge, passed away on Tuesday, November 21, 2017 at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville. He was born in Pittsburgh, PA, a son of the late Albert Charles Mueser and Anna E. (Earl) Mueser.

Mr. Mueser was a 1968 Graduate of Millvale High School in PA, and received his Bachelor's in education from Pitt University in 1972. Al was a teacher for 19 years at Cambridge High School and a tutor for 18 years at Muskingum College. After retirement, Al had worked as a clerk at Reisbeck's and was the office manager at the Children's Dyslexia Center.

Al was a board member of the Open Arms Pregnancy Center, he was a 4th Degree Knight of Columbus. He was president of the church league softball for 22 years where he was known as "Big Al". He loved playing basketball and golfing with his friends. He was a die hard fan of anything Pittsburgh, especially the Steelers. Al was a frequent traveler and enjoyed working outdoors. He was an avid Right to Life supporter and a very dedicated and active member of Christ Our Light Parish.

Al leaves his wife of 44 years, Judith E. (Krizanic) Mueser, they were married on August 10, 1973; their children, Amber R. (John C. Vaught II)

MueserVaught of North Canton, Tasia R. Mueser of Cambridge and Vincent N. Mueser of North Canton; one granddaughter Ava R. Vaught; and a brother Robert E. Mueser of Pittsburgh. He was a beloved husband, cherished father and adored Pop Pop.

Al is preceded in death by an infant daughter Judith Eileen Mueser.
