



Dr. Albert Clifton Smith Jr.

November 18, 1917 - July 19, 2015

Dr. Albert Clifton Smith Jr. age 97 of Brunswick, formerly of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, July 19, 2015 at Southwest General Hospice in Strongsville, Ohio. He was born on November 18, 1917 in Puerto Rico, a son of the late Dr. Albert Clifton Smith Sr. and Emma Freeman White Smith.

Dr. Smith served his country during World War II in the Army Air Corp Medical Department. He practiced in South Carolina before moving to Cambridge where he was an OB-GYN Physician from 1956 to 1987. He attended the Unity Presbyterian Church. He was a member of the V.F.W. Post 2901, the Cambridge Elks and Kiwanis; and a volunteer for Hospice and the Salvation Army.

Clifton is survived by: his wife Heleanna M. Lori Smith, whom he married on March 5, 1982; daughter Caroline (Stephen) Pierson of Cambridge; son Nick (Carla) Smith of Cambridge; step-daughter Lori S. (Matthew) Sherwood of Brunswick; step-son Rob Barr & Kim Lott of Trenton; brother William P. He is preceded in death by: his parents; a sister Elizabeth Butler and a brother Robert L. Smith.
