Albert Zip Joseph, age 81 of Cambridge, passed away Sunday, March 16, 2003. He was born October 4, 1921 in New Kensington, PA. Al was a retired Teacher at Cambridge High School for 33 years. A member of the Church of Life Giving Fountain Greek Orthodox Church in Martins Ferry, Ohio. A WW II Army veteran, Al received the Purple Heart for wounds received in combat in the Battle of the Bulge. Coached Basketball and Football at Cambridge High School. Graduate of West Liberty State College, Manager of Cambridge Municipal Pool for 12 years, Elks Lodge - Martins Ferry, Ohio. Taught Golf, Ceramic and Oil Painting Classes. He was a 1940 National High School Basketball Scoring Champion and enjoyed being a Basketball Official. Mr. Joseph was preceded in death by his parents Tony Joseph and Cassa Kahlil Joseph. One brother Edmund Joseph.

Albert is survived by his wife Madelyn Hartill Joseph whom he married June 26, 1971. One son Eugene Joseph of Martins Ferry, Ohio, One Step Daughter Shari Braden of Cambridge, Ohio.
