



Allen "Floyd" Duhamel

Allen "Floyd" Duhamel, age 82 of Cambridge, passed away on Saturday, May 15, 2021 at his home. He was born on April 11, 1939 in Coshocton, a son of the late Harry Floyd Duhamel and Helen Irene (Lacey) Fletcher.

Floyd was a member of First Christian Church since 1959. He served many terms as deacon and was a trustee for many years as well. He fixed whatever needed fixed, even when he wasn't a trustee. He was a trustee *ameritis*.

He married his wife of almost 59 years, Shirley Brand on June 3, 1962. Also left behind are: son David (Lisa) Duhamel; daughter Diana (Jason) McElroy; sister Judy Tobin; grandson Landon (Ivy) Duhamel; great granddaughter Lilliana Duhamel; uncle Don (Joyce) Lacey; and many nieces and nephews. Floyd is preceded in death by: his parents; a brother Harry; and step father Paul Fletcher.

He graduated from Brown High School in 1958 and was a carpenter all his working years. Many homes in Cambridge have been fixed and remodeled by him and his helpers. He passed a lot of knowledge to the young men who worked with him.
