



## Americo L. Vergari

November 14, 1921 - November 8, 2011

Americo L. Vergari age 89 of Cambridge, Ohio passed away November 8, 2011 at the Pacifica Senior Assisted Living in Santa Clarita, California. He was born on November 14, 1921 in Kusequa, PA, son of the late Galliano and Maddelena Vergari. He was a 1942 graduate of Brown High School in Cambridge, and was married to Sara Ann Vergari, who passed away in 1996. He was living both in Cambridge and California for the last 20 years. After his stroke in 2007, he moved permanently to Santa Clarita, CA., to be near his family. He served honorably in the US Army during WWII, where he served much of his time in the South Pacific. Following his discharge, he returned to Cambridge where he worked as a projectionist at the various theaters, owned his own coin operated business in many of the local businesses, owned a music store in Caldwell and eventually owned the Vergari's State Theater. He was a member of St. Benedict Catholic Church in Cambridge and Blessed Kateri Catholic Church in Santa Clarita, CA., and a member of the Elks, VFW and Masonic Lodge. Survivors include his daughter, Madeline Vergari Neumann, a son Richard Vergari, and grandchildren Gina and Rico Neumann, and Chase and Ryan Vergari.
