



## Andrew Ronald "Ron" Roby

November 10, 1934 - January 2, 2022

Andrew Ronald "Ron" Roby, age 87 of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, January 2, 2022 at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. He was born on November 10, 1934 in Cambridge, a son of the late Andrew Roby and Viola May (Archer) Thompson.

Mr. Roby was a 1952 graduate of Cambridge High School. He had worked in retail at J.C. Penney's in Cambridge and later on at Sears in Columbus where he retired.
