Barbara Dianne (Dee) Hodges passed quietly and comfortably at the family farm surrounded by love, on December 26, 2017.

Dianne was born on February 26, 1933 to Albert Bartlett Davis and Helen Margaret (Sarchet) Davis. She and her brothers, Larry A. Davis and the late Marc S. Davis grew up in Southern Ohio and later settled in Newcomerstown, Ohio in the 1940's. She attended and graduated from Newcomerstown High School in 1950 where she co-authored her school's Alma Mater. Dianne went on to The Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio where she earned her bachelor's degree in Social Services. She also met her late husband, of 58 years, Robert (Bob) Roy Hodges at OSU during a social dance and they married in June of 1954. Dianne and Bob were foster parents until the birth of their son Bruce Robert in July of 1964.

Dianne loved gathering with her high school classmates and their spouses. Dianne taught at the Golden Rule School in Byesville, Ohio and taught English as a second language in Columbus, Ohio to wives of OSU graduate students and professors. Dianne cared for many friends and family members during her lifetime and always had time to visit friends that were shut in at home or in nursing care.

Dianne was proud of her home town and enjoyed the Cambridge performing and visual arts. She loved attending City Band Concerts with her late husband and grandchildren. Dianne was a true shepherd, always putting others before herself spreading her love and kindness.

Dianne is survived by her brother Larry Albert Davis and his wife Sterry Lines (Kimball) Davis of Virginia; her beloved son Bruce Robert Hodges and daughter-in-law Anna Lynn of Cambridge, Ohio; her grandchildren, Elizabeth Jane Hodges of Cleveland, Ohio, Kaitlynn Dianne Brady and her husband Aaron Jacob Brady of Norfolk, Virginia, Caryn Leigh Hodges of Cambridge, Ohio, Patrick Robert Clifford Hodges of Cambridge, Ohio and many cousins, nieces and nephews.
