Ben R. Bradley 73 of Cambridge died at his home June 4, 2010. He was born in Herald, IL June 21, 1936. He was the son of Lee and Everal Webb Bradley. He was a salesman for Reed Bits and co-owner of Bradley Drilling.

He graduated from Carmi High School in 1954 and attended Murray State University on a Football Scholarship. Ben loved sports particularly football and basketball. In later years he enjoyed attending his grandchildren's sporting events. He is a member of the Carmi High School Athletic Hall of Fame.
