May 10, 1919 - January 15, 2014

Betty J. Oliver, 94, passed away peacefully in her sleep on January 15, 2014. She was born in Cambridge, Ohio on May 10, 1919.

Betty married the love of her life, Clifford B. Oliver, on July 20, 1940 and they were married for 34 years prior to Clifford's passing in 1974. After WWII, they both settled in the Cleveland area where they raised their two sons, Curtis B. and the late Richard L. Oliver.

Betty was an early career woman, although she would never have described herself as such. She worked for Cleveland Trust Company for more than 30 years, being promoted to Branch Manager before she took early retirement. The early retirement didn't last long as Betty soon began working at Halle Brothers and later for a medical lab. She didn't actually retire from work until she was in her late 70's. During that time she formed many friendships and was dedicated to her faith at Rockport Methodist Church in Rocky River.

Betty's real strength came from her family. Always her family came first. She was the Aunt who contacted all family members including her nieces, nephews, brothers and sisters and then shared family news with everyone. She so loved her grandchildren, Brian(Kelli), Lisa(Rick), Lindsay(Greg), the late Blair and her step grandchildren, Sean and Kane. Brian and Lisa also gave her six great grandchildren, Blake, Kyle, Katy, Emily, Lily and Jennifer who all affectionately called her GG (Great Grandmother). She had the rare privilege to see her grandchildren become adults and watch her great grandchildren become teenagers or very close to it.

Additionally, Betty was a big part of the lives of her daughter in laws and their husbands. Karen (Bill), Nancy(Doug) and Suzanne(Curt) each of whom touched her life with love and kindness, that she readily returned.

Preceding Betty in death are her siblings, Harold Tedrick, Kenny Tedrick, Marjorie Nelson and Kate Douglass.

A family ceremony in Cambridge, Ohio is planned for Saturday January 25th, 2014 with internment immediately following the service.
