



## Bruce A. Wierzbicki

September 26, 1954 - September 3, 2014

Bruce A. Wierzbicki, age 59 of Senecaville, passed away on Wednesday, September 3, 2014 at Ohio State University Medical Center. He was born on September 26, 1954 in Akron, a son of Alice (Movens) Wierzbicki of Hudson and the late Frank Wierzbicki.

Bruce was a retired Golf Course Superintendant at Cambridge Country Club. He served his country in the U.S. Air Force and was a member of the Southeastern Ohio Paddlers.
