Charles A. Johnson, 91 of Coshocton, passed away on Thursday, April 11, 2013 at Autumn Health Care in Coshocton. He was born on December 6, 1921 in Cambridge, a son of the late Austin Johnson and Nellie (Cropper) Johnson.

Mr. Johnson served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II. He worked at Simonds Tools, formerly Holler Tools in Newcomerstown for 42 years and was a member of the Kimbolton United Methodist Church. He was a farmer who enjoyed gardening and a member of Liberty Township Fire Department. He and his wife were on the committees and helped with the Kimbolton Homecoming every year.

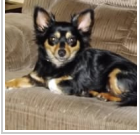
