



## Charles Curt Kittle

July 20, 1943 - January 26, 2011

Charles C. "Curt" Kittle, 67 of Lore City died Wednesday, January 26, 2011 following a lengthy illness.

Mr. Kittle was a self-employed home inspector and taught real estate continuing education classes for many years. He was a former football, baseball and jr. high girls basketball coach at Buckeye Trail and was inducted into the East Guernsey School District Hall of Fame in 2005 for his many years of service as coach, volunteer, and long-time president of the Buckeye Trail Athletic Boosters. For the past four years he was an avid supporter of the Malone University women's basketball team.

He was a graduate of Glouster High School and Ohio University.

Born July 20, 1943 in Athens, he was the son of Charles Kittle of Glouster and the late Barbara (Knight) Kittle. In addition to his father, he is survived by his wife, Patricia (Gallogly) Kittle, who he married on September 19, 1981; three children, Kathy (Larry) Silvus of Lowell, Brian Kittle of Caldwell, and Amy Kittle of the home; three grandchildren, Niki Phillis, Megan Silvus and Scott Silvus; and a great-grandson, Luke Phillis.

He was preceded in death by; his mother, Barbara and a brother, Steve Kittle.
