June 12, 1931 - November 27, 2019

Charles A. Upton, age 88 of Cambridge, passed away on Wednesday, November 27, 2019 at his home. He was born on June 12, 1931 in Cambridge, a son of the late William Teutonic Upton and Hazel Dell (Hammond) Upton.

Mr. Upton began working as a teenager at the Kroger Store in 1947 then left for the service in 1950. He returned to Cambridge in 1954 from the Army and worked another 25 years at Krogers and 10 years for Pennyfare. He started the Cambridge Glass Club which later became the National Cambridge Collectors Club. He was a member Mt. Hermon Presbyterian Church for over 65 years. He was a 32 degree Mason and a member of the Guernsey Lodge #66 F& AM, and the Scottish Rite Valley of Cambridge. He also enjoyed working genealogy.

Charles was preceded in death by: his parents; his wife of 65 years Mary Alice (Porter) Upton, on August 20, 2019; a son-in-law Dale Saft; a brother Richard "Dick" Upton and two sisters, Thelma Thomas and Marjorie Welch.
