Christ Lekorenos, 80, of Cambridge, passed away Monday, November 8, 2010. Christ was born February 15, 1930, in Dover, OH.

He served his country four years in the U.S. Navy as a medical corpman. During the Korean Conflict he was attached to the Merchant Marines air-sea rescue unit based in Argentia Newfoundland. Christ earned degrees from both Massillon City Hospital School of Nursing and the University of Akron. He began his career at SEORMC in 1970 when he was hired as director of nursing. In 1994 he retired as vice president of patient care. Christ will be remembered for his enthusiasm and love of family and the community, often taking the lead in various organizations.

Survived by his loving wife of 57 years, Marie (Dolmas) Lekorenos; his children Christen Lekorenos and George Lekorenos; brother Ted (Barbara) Lekorenos, sisters Ann Isbell and Mary (Ted) Glaros; grandchildren Tali Elena Lekorenos and Gabriel Lekorenos Arnold. He is also survived by several nieces, nephews and godchildren.
