Cloea Landman Fleming, age 98, of Maple Heights, Cambridge, died Thursday, December 26, 2002 at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. She was the daughter of the late David N. Landman and Annie Masters Landman.

Mrs. Fleming was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Cambridge. She was a School Teacher from 1924 to 1929, was a homemaker, and worked at The Daily Jeffersonian. Among her affiliations were being a part of: Valley Grange, NLC Class, United Methodist Women, The American Legion Aux.. She also attended Muskingum College for 2 years.

Her first teaching job was at a one room school house at Flat Iron, after that she taught at Garfield Elementary.

Cloea was married on March 30, 1929 to Russell D. Fleming, he died on July 22, 1988. Also proceeding her in death is a half sister Cynthia McConnell.
