Constance Bowlin Carroll, age 64 of Cambridge, passed away on Wednesday, December 5, 2018 at Ohio State University Medical Center. She was born on November 8, 1954 in Chicago, IL. a daughter of Phyllis Nadine (Boner) Bowlin of Cambridge and the late Thomas A. Bowlin Sr.

Mrs. Carroll was a 1972 graduate of Cambridge High School.
