April 8, 1916 - June 27, 2002

Cora E. Milligan, age 86, dearly beloved wife of the late Harold Milligan passed away in Whittier, Ca. June 27, 2002. She was born April 8, 1916, the fourth child of the late Ben and Florence Eckelberry Clemens. Cora passed away into eternity Thursday June 27, 2002 in Whittier, Ca. Cora attended the country school in Birds Run, and completed her education at Newcomerstown, Ohio. Before Cora's mother was married, Cora's grandmother told her, "There must be true ministers of God in this world like we read of in the Bible, who follow the teachings of Jesus. Accept them when they come!" Our father in heaven looked down upon Grandma Eckleberry's seeking heart, answering her prayer and sent two handmaidens of the Lord to their district in 1915. Cora, herself, made her choice to serve the Lord at the age of eleven.

During the war years, Cora did office work in Shelby, Ohio until she was united in marriage with Harold Milligan on June 2, 1948. Harold and Cora made their home in North Salem, Ohio.
