D. "Glenn" Nicholson, age 83 of Cambridge, passed away on Saturday, October 6, 2018 at his home. He was born on February 18, 1935 in Jerusalem, Ohio a son of the late George W. Nicholson and Bertha (Finch) Nicholson.

Glenn was a 1953 graduate of Cambridge High School. He worked all his life in the equipment business. He retired from Case IH in sales and service after 25 years.
