



## Daniel Dee Ringer

September 25, 1939 - August 4, 2014

Daniel Dee Ringer, age 74 of Kimbolton, passed away on Monday, August 4, 2014 at Ohio State University Medical Center, surrounded by his loving family. He was born on September 25, 1939 in the same house he lived in; the son of the late Lawrence E. Ringer and Lucille (Hatcher) Ringer.
