



## Dr. Deborah K. Thompson

December 24, 1947 - March 1, 2019

Dr. Deborah K. Thompson passed away on March 1, 2019 after suffering a brain aneurysm. Deb was born on December 24, 1947 to Robert and Olive Harrop Thompson. She graduated from Cambridge High School in 1966, and earned her bachelors degree from Kent State University. In 1972 she completed her Masters of Art in physical Education from The Ohio State University. Deb coached tennis at the University of Arkansas where she earned her Doctorate in Education. She moved to McKenzie Tennessee in 1982 and taught at Bethel University, where she received numerous Leadership Awards. Dr. Thompson was awarded the status of Faculty Emeritus before her retirement in 2016.

She is survived by one cousin, Lloyd Robert Thompson of Cambridge and many dear and long time friends.
