Donald Frontz, age 82 of Cambridge, died Wednesday, February 4, 2009 at his home. He was born on February 7, 1926 in Cambridge, a son of the late Roy Frontz and Bertha C. Harper Frontz.

Mr. Frontz was a member of the First Christian Church in Cambridge and was a Life Member of the V.F.W. post 2901. He served his country in the Army during W.W.II. He was aboard the SS Leopoldville during the Battle of the Buldge.

Donald was a retired Fire Chief and head of Security at the Cambridge State Hospital. After retirement he drove for the Guernsey County Senior Citizens. Surviving are: his wife, Betty L. Harbin Frontz of the home, they were married on October 17, 1946; a daughter, Nancy Frontz Fredrick Gress of Cambridge; a sister, Ima Jane Mizer of Cambridge; two grandchildren, Alex and Emma Gress and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by: a son Glenn D. Frontz on Feb. 22, 1989; a daughter, Cynthia; a brother Jack Lee Frontz; and a sister, Dora Morrow.

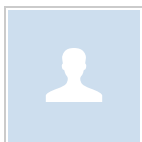
