November 19, 1933 - February 16, 2019

Dr. Donald S. Small DVM, age 85 of Cambridge, Ohio passed away February 16, 2019 at his residence. He was born on November 19, 1933 in Martinsburg, WVA., to the late William and Grace (Kilmer) Small. Also preceding him in death was a daughter Terri Lynn Small and a brother Howard Small. Dr. Small did his undergraduate studies at the University of Maryland and the West Virginia University, and graduated Cum Laude from the Ohio State University school of Veterinarian Medicine in 1959. He was founder and former owner of the Guernsey Veterinary Clinic 1961. He was a member of the Alpha Psi Fraternity a veterinarian fraternity, Ohio Veterinarian Assoc., American Veterinarian Assoc., Center United Methodist Church, Avid Buckeye Fan, and was a Private Pilot. 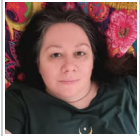
