Dorothy E. Lake Chase Henderson, age 95 of Old Washington, died Sunday, April 15, 2007 at Grant Medical Center in Columbus as the result of an auto accident. She was born February 1, 1912 in Guernsey County to the late Arthur Lake and Lily Stockdale Lake.

Mrs. Henderson along with being a homemaker taught in a one room school house in Antrim and worked at Londonderry Schools as a cook. She was a member of The Old Washington United Methodist Church, member of the Golden Sixties, a charter member of the United Methodist Women in Antrim and a current member of the Methodist Women in Old Washington. She was a former member of the Guernsey County Board of Education. She was an avid Buckeye Trail and Ohio State Fan.
