Duane "Roger" Picklesimer age 67 of Cambridge, Ohio went to be with his Lord, encircled with the love of many family members on Oct. 22, 2010 at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. He was born on Dec. 20, 1942 in Nolan, West Virginia to the late Hurschel and June (Cantrell) Picklesimer. Roger was a Army veteran of the Vietnam War, retired as an Insurance agent and a member of Christ United Methodist Church. He had a long, successful career as a hard working, dedicated manager for Safeway Grocery Stores in Northern Virginia, and he was held in high regards and was in charged with running their busiest and most profitable stores. In pursuit of his long time dream of living in the Shenandoah Valley he moved his family to Elkton, Va. in 1981. They opened a small grocery store "Picklesimer's Grocery". While living in Elkton, Roger was very active in the community, and was one of the founders of EPIC and was active in the Lions Club. Roger in his typical unselfish way suggested moving to Cambridge so they could be closer to Joan's father. Once here he embarked on a third career as a Sales Representative for Prudential where he earned his CLU, and ended his working career with American General Life and Accident.
