“ We are so sorry to hear of Aunt Faye's passing. She was loved and respected by so many. I will never forget the weekends I spent at Grandma's little trailer next door to the store. It was a short walk across to the backdoor of Aunt Faye and Uncle Roger's. He was usually pumping gas or fixing tires or loading feed and she was managing the rest and usually cooking, canning or sewing...I still have a dress, probably my first, that she made from dotted swiss fabric.

The tales and fussing between Aunt Faye and Dad are legendary. My fondest tale heard year after year is that to beat Dad and Mom's garden, Aunt Faye would be out in her garden in her nightgown after dark with a flashlight and blow dryer encouraging her first plants from the ground.

She never appeared to be too surprised by anything. I remember one afternoon, someone came into the store and told her that 4-year old Danny and my grandfather Floyd Dawson were in the street throwing rocks at each other. She just shook her head and kept slicing meat or packing groceries.

I have and cherish two of her quilts.
