Edith Meighen age 92 formerly of Sebring , passed away on Monday, October 25, 2010 at the home of her son. A daughter of the late Marion A. Board and Florence (Reif) Board. She grew up in W.VA. and attended Hillsdale College in Michigan, where she also served as secretary to the college president and assistant Registrar.

She was preceded in death by her husband, John Robert Meighen in 1996.
