Edward O. Donohue age 82 of Cambridge, OH passed away Friday August 24, 2012 at The Cambridge Health and Rehabilitation Center ( Kindred System). Born January 27, 1930 to Norman E. and Mary Ethel Loritsch Donohue in Cambridge, OH. Mr. Donohue was retired from The Adult Parole Authority in 1981. Served as a Parole-Probation Officer and Case Analyst. A 1947 Graduate of Cambridge High School. Received a degree in Music Education from Muskingum University in 1956.
