Eileen A. Cochran, died Friday, September 19, 2008 at 2:15am at the Victorian Oaks. She was born Eileen Annice Sutley on March 25, 1920 in Newark, Oh. She was 88. She was preceded in death by her parents Ray Henry Sutley and Florence Opal Cooperrider Sutley; 1 sister, Margaret "Peggy" Cawthon; her 1st husband, Clayton E. Bell and 2nd husband, Lawrence A. Cochran.

Upon retiring from teaching she was active in tutoring and the Literacy Council. She was a life long member of Christ Lutheran Church of Cambridge, where she was in various committees and for many years sang in the choir. She belonged to the cancer society, the Delta Cappa Gamma Sorority, the Cambridge Concert

Association, the Celtic Society, the Parkinson's Society and the Ohio Teachers Association and Retired Teachers Association.

She loved music , especially jazz and the big bands and dancing, swimming and reading.
