On Friday May 23, 2014, Elizabeth Ann Bugos Abrams passed into new life at the Beckett House, New Concord, after a lingering illness. She was 84.

Born July 30, 1929 near Salt Fork, she was the ninth of ten children, the daughter of Michael S. and Anna Katherine Hlavaty Bugos. She was the last of her generation of the family.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Gilbert (Gib) Abrams in 1987, and whom she married August 26, 1950. 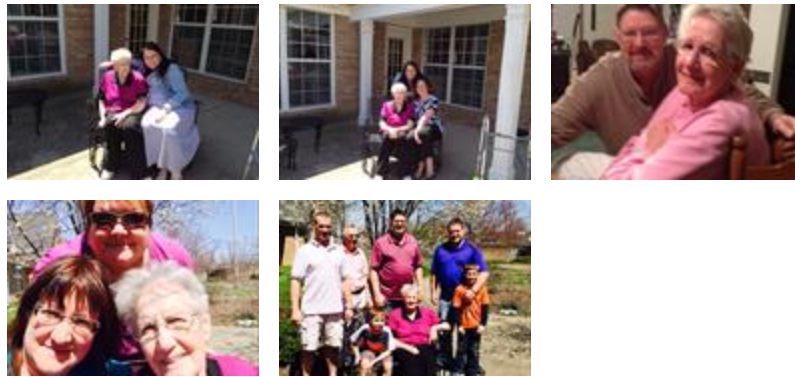
