



## Ernest Junior Weisenstine

Ernest Junior Weisenstine, age 86 of Cambridge, died Sunday, March 8, 2009 at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. He was born in Cambridge on July 12, 1922, a son of the late Ernest M. Weisenstine and Celia Stewart Weisenstine.
