



## Estalene Law

June 11, 1911 - June 18, 2009

Isa Estalene Law, age 98, of Cambridge, Ohio went to be with her Lord and Savior at 1:30 pm on Thursday, June 18, 2009 surrounded by her family. She was at The Beckett House at New Concord, Ohio, where she was for a short stay to receive physical therapy.

She was born on June 11, 1911 in Chaseville, near Senecaville Ohio to the late C.A. and Olive Williams Lashley. Her mother passed away in 1913. She was raised by her stepmother, the late Dora Finley Lashley. She and the late Benson Boyd Law were married on May 3, 1930. They were married for 68 years when Benson died in July 1998.

She has been a member of Ninth Street United Methodist Church in Cambridge, Ohio for over 60 years. She was a very active member of the Church. She taught the Miller Bible Class, an adult Sunday school class, for over 50 years. She was a former member of the administrative board of the Church and was an active member of United Methodist Women. She also mentored young adults as they joined the Church. Prior to her membership at Ninth Street United Methodist Church, she was a member of Quaker City United Methodist Church.

Estalene is a graduate of Muskingum College and Lore City High School. She was an elementary school teacher for 41 years having started her career in a one-room school house. She taught in rural schools in Guernsey, Harrison and Noble counties. She taught more than 20 years at Madison Consolidated Schools before moving to Cambridge City Schools where she taught the

remainder of her career as a third grade teacher at Park Elementary School. She is survived by one son, Milton O. Annajean Law of Cambridge. One granddaughter, Betsy Law John Burgess of Brecksville, Ohio, one grandson, James M. Jennifer Law of Cambridge, two great granddaughters Brittany Lynn and Nicolette Jamie Law of Cambridge, two half-brothers, Dallas Lashley of Cambridge and Forrest Lashley of Steubenville, Ohio, and a special friend and care-giver, Martha Laurie of Cambridge. In addition to her parents and her husband, she was preceded in death by one sister, Marie Lashley Frame, two half-brothers, and one half-sister.

Calling hours will be observed from 2:00 pm to 4:00pm and from 7:00 pm to 9:00pm on Sunday, June 21, 2009 at Bundy-Law Funeral Home.
