



Felix F. "Phil" DeLuca

February 8, 1929 - January 4, 2018

Felix F. "Phil" DeLuca, age 88 of Cambridge, passed away on January 4, 2018 at the Beckett House in New Concord. He was born in Clarksburg, West Virginia, a son of the late Patsy DeLuca and Ann (Maiocco) DeLuca.

Mr. DeLuca was raised in Steubenville before joining the United States Air Force and serving his country. During his enlistment he was a member of the Singing Sergeant's in Alaska from 1950 to 1952.

After the service, Phil went to the University of Steubenville and obtained his bachelors degree. He worked for over 25 years at the Cambridge State Hospital as personnel director. He was a long standing parishioner at Christ Our Light Parish (St. Benedict's Catholic Church) in Cambridge and also a member of the Eagles, Elks and V.F. W. in Cambridge.

He is preceded in death by: his parents; his wife Josephine Marie (Yonadi) DeLuca on May 20, 2009; and a nephew Thomas Grandillo.

Surviving are: two daughters, Toni Ann DeLuca of Columbus, and Tina Marie (Todd) Callahan of Bonita Springs, FL; granddaughters, Katie Joe and Brice Philip Callahan; a brother Patsy (Rachel) DeLuca of Steubenville; a sister Lucy (DeLuca) Grandillo of Dayton; and several nieces and nephews.
