Fred Mike Andrews Sr. age 92 of Cambridge, Ohio passed away February 2, 2017 at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. He was born on May 28, 1924 in Cambridge, Ohio to the late Mike H. and Shafica (Bushala) Andrews. Also preceding him in death was 2 sisters Alice and Helen Andrews. He was a 1942 Graduate of Cambridge Brown High School, 1942-43 Attended College at University of Pennsylvania, 1943-45 a Merchant Marines, Owner Mike Andrews Produce Company- named business manager of the year, and owner of Food Distributors, Former owner of Byesville and Cambridge IGA from 1985-2005, Cambridge School Board elected and served 36 years from 1962-2007 and was president for 28 years, Cambridge Country Club- longtime member and board member served as president in 1977 & 1997, Cambridge Elks Club from 1956 to present served as trustee & head trustee, Cambridge Moose- 2010 to present, State Highway Patrol Auxiliary member from 1948-1985 and served as a major from 1985-1995, Cambridge High School Hall of Fame in 1999, Clock Keeper Cambridge Basketball from 1944-1980, and football from 1944-2004, Ohio State Athletic Committee and president club member from 1983-2017, life long Ohio State and Cambridge athletic fan and supporter, Fred and Janet actually attended the 1950 snow bowl at Ohio State vs. Michigan on one of their first dates. Fred is survived by his wife Janet Ann (Pulley) Andrews of whom he married on July 3, 1955, 3 sons Fred (Mike) Andrews Jr. of Cambridge, William (Beth) Andrews of Pickerington, Ronald John (Deanna) Andrews of Cambridge,
