Galen Russell Frame, 79, passed away at the Autumn Healthcare Center in Cambridge Tuesday, April 3, 2012. He was born near Lore City May 12, 1932 to C.E. (Cleland) and Marie Lashley Frame.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Marie Falkenstein Frame, and son Eric Frame, a brother Lowell Frame and an infant brother.

He is survived by four stepchildren: Dolores and Ted Mosolf of Montana, Rita Rice of Columbus, Ohio; and Gloria Gilbert of California and their families. He is also survived by one brother Wendell Frame of PA, three sisters Becky Stillion of Cambridge, Alice Caw of Zanesville, and Janet Morgan of Quaker City and one granddaughter Carishea Frame and many nieces, nephews, relatives and friends of this area.

He attended Old Washington School all twelve years and was a member of the class of 1950. He was also a graduate of Muskingum College where he received a Bachelor's Degree with a specialty in Geology. He was a member of the Mt. Zion Church in Pleasant City and a lifetime member of the V.F.W. post 2901. As a young boy he spent time working in his father's machinery business putting together all kinds of implements and helping with the family business.

He served in the army in the Military Police being stationed for periods of time in Germany, Austria and England. After the service he taught one year at Liberty School and then became employed with Columbia Gas where he worked for a while in Athens, Cambridge, and finally Washington, PA until

retirement.
