George James McMahon, age 74, of Cambridge, died Friday, July 19, 2002 at 12:45am, at the Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. Born on November 23, 1927 in Bridgeport, New Jersey to the late George James McMahon Sr. and Ella Willets McMahon.

Mr. McMahon served a long and esteemed military career. He served for a total of 24 years, during World War II, The Korean War and the Vietnam War. He served in the Navy from 1945 to 1956, the Air Force from 1956 to 1964 and the Army from 1964 to 1968
