George Kenneth Aikin, age 92 of Cambridge, died Thursday, May 26, 2005 at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center. He was a son of the late George Mitchell Aiken and Late Winona Lawrence Aikin. He was a member of the Unity Presbyterian Church in Cambridge.

Mr. Aiken was a Principal and Teacher for 36 years. He was in the U.S. Army as a Sergeant during W.W. II in the 4th Infantry Division. He was awarded a Purple Heart in the Battle of The Bulge. He was: a past Elder in 2nd Presbyterian Church for several years; in the Men's Barbershop Chorus for several years and was a 1937 graduate of Muskingum College.

Kenny was married on August 19, 1939 to his wife Annabelle Mathews Aikin, she died in 2001.
