October 5, 1914 - October 18, 2017

Glenn O. Burris, age 103 of Cambridge, passed away on Wednesday, October 18, 2017 at The Cambridge Place. He was born on October 5, 1914 in Cambridge, a son of the late Homer W. Burris and Hattie B. (Warne) Burris. Mr. Burris was a member of the Beckett Avenue United Methodist Church. Glenn and his three brothers all served in the U.S. Army during W.W.II. He worked at Suitt Brothers, Cambridge Pottery and Superior Model and retired from the Cambridge Post Office. Glenn was a member of the D.A.V. Guernsey Post 28.

Glenn was preceded in death by: his parents, his wife Phyllis R. (Dennis) Burris whom he married on November 20, 1942; two sisters, Martha Liddell and Frances Day; three brothers John, Paul and Warren Burris; a son-in-law Ed Cain; two grandsons and a granddaughter.
