May 27, 1927 - July 17, 2011

Gloria Frances Newland Clary, age 84 of Cambridge, passed away Sunday, July 17, 2011 at The Cambridge Health and Rehabilitation Center. She was born May 27, 1927 in Martins Ferry, Ohio, daughter of the late Clayton E. & Janet Heller Newland. She was preceded in death by her loving husband Harold R. Clary, whom she married on July 18, 1952; sister Virginia Newland Merrelli; brother Edward C. Newland; brother-in-laws Art Merrelli and Charles Patterson.

Gloria graduated from Shreve High School in the Class of 1945, was a member of the First Baptist Church in Martins Ferry; Faithful Sunday School Class; Baptist Youth Fellowship Church Choir; and Women's Missionary Society. When she married Harold, she became a member of The Ninth Street United Methodist Church in Cambridge. She taught classes in the Nursery and Kindergarten; was in charge of summer Bible School; a member of The Mary Reed Circle and an officer of the United Methodist Women. As a Mom, she served as Vice President of Glass Plant PTA, Leader and Den mother for the Cub Scouts of America and was a devout Cambridge High band, football, and wrestling parent. She was also a member of Jr. Women's League, Golden Sixties and helped organize the local chapter of AARP, where she served as treasurer numerous times.

She was a member of numerous support groups that included: S.E.O.R.M.C. VIP's, Cancer Copers, Board Member of the American Cancer Society, Desert Storm Parents - raising money for the monument at the court house; Triple E.

Investment Group; Guernsey Herb groups and Guernsey County Senior Citizens; and secretary and president for the Cambridge Heights Tenants Assn. Over the years she worked for several local business including: Montgomery Ward, Cowgills Inc., C.M. Luburgh Const. in Zanesville, OH; Shenandoah Inn - Old Washington, OH; Salt Fork State Park, and the Union Bus Terminal where she retired in 1987. She and her husband were involved in all the activities of their children. They enjoyed life together and traveled over the United States, Canada, Mexico, and Hawaii many times. She is survived by two sons; H. Richard (Cathy) Clary II of Niceville, FL and Mark (Debbie) Clary of Cambridge, OH. Granddaughter Caryn S. Clary her fiancé Jeremy Rice of Cambridge, Grandsons: H. Richard (Rachelle) Clary III of Camp Pendleton, CA, Robert (Katie) Clary and great-grandson Odin Clary (due any day) of Milton, FL, three sister-in-laws: Martha Ann Clary Wilson, Mary Lou Clary Patterson, and Carol Newland.
