Gregory Jay Wells, age 39 of Old Washington, died Tuesday, October 1, 2002, at Scripps Memorial Hospital Trauma Center in San Diego, California. He is the son of Patricia K. Kaplet who lives in Cambridge with step father John Kaplet, his father is Frederick Aurthor Wells , he and a special friend, Sandra Ashcraft live in Marietta, Ohio.

Greg was the Owner Operator of Oak Hill Mobile Home Village, and Manager of Eagle Fireworks, Inc.. He attended the Old Washington United Methodist Church. He was also a 1982 Graduate of Buckeye Trail High School.
