H. Dwayne Ross, 90, passed away Tuesday, April 9, 2024 at his home after a battle with cancer.

He was born August 2, 1933, a son of the late Harper and Irene (Huff) Ross. He lived most of his life on the family farm near Bloomfield, Ohio.

In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by brothers-in-law, John Mathers, George Balogh, and Robert Shirer, his mother and father-in-law, Alpha and John W. Oliver.

He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Joan (Oliver) Ross, children, Julie (Mark) Blackstone, John (Sherry Cross) Ross and Joy (Steve) Lucas. He was a lifelong member of Bloomfield Presbyterian Church. He also enjoyed membership in the Buckeye Allis Club.
