Hank Wendorf, age 87 of Cambridge, passed away on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 at Genesis Health Care in Zanesville. He was born on April 25, 1932 in Ravenna, Ohio, a son of the late Harris S. Wendorf and Elizabeth M. (Mertz) Wendorf.

Mr. Wendorf was a Korean War Veteran, having served in the United States Air Force. He was a very active and involved member of St. John's Episcopal Church. Hank worked and retired from V.N.
