



## Harlan R. Bennett

December 8, 1922 - March 30, 2004

Harlan R. Bennett, age 81, of Gahanna, formerly of Cambridge, died Tuesday, March 30, 2004 at HCR Manor Care in Westerville, Ohio. He was a son of the late Charles D. Bennett and late Laura Dean Bennett.

Mr. Bennett was a member of the Unity Presbyterian Church in Cambridge and a member of Mifflin Presbyterian Church in Gahanna, Ohio.

He was a Manager of Harold's Royal Blue Supermarket in Cambridge and was Co-owner of Bennett Brother's Farm. He was a graduate of Cambridge High School in 1940. He served in the U.S. Army in W.W.II. He was a member of the Scottish Rite Valley in Cambridge, a member of the Guernsey Lodge #632 F&AM, member of the Alladin Shrine of Columbus.

Harlan was married to Leah J. Bennett in 1959, she died in July of 2003.
