



Harold D. Bennett

June 30, 1915 - March 29, 2003

Harold D. Bennett, age 87 of Cambridge, died Saturday, March 29, 2003 at Southeastern Ohio Regional Medical Center, after an extended illness. He was a son of the late Charles D. Bennett and Laura Dean Bennett.

He was a member of the Unity Presbyterian Church in Cambridge. He was employed at Cambridge Glass in the payroll office, he owned and operated 2 Harold's Royal Blue Stores, he was Co-Owner of The Guernsey Glass Company, Owner of the Cambridge Glass Museum and Co-Owner of the Bennett's Brothers Farm.

Mr. Bennett was a past member of the Cambridge City Council, past member of the Cambridge Rotary, he was a graduate of Cambridge High School in 1934 and a graduate of Cambridge Business School. He loved Cambridge Glass and Antiques and he loved Belgian Draft Horses and Miniture Ponies. Harold was married on December 5, 1948 to his wife Dorothy E. Larrick Judy Bennett of Cambridge.

Surviving are 2 sisters: Shirley Jack Bogart of Cambridge, Patricia Bennett Custer of Lakewood, Ohio, a brother; Harlan Leah Bennett of Gahanna, Ohio, a sister-in-law; Virginia Bennett of Cambridge, several cousins; Charles & Barb, Tom & Beth Warne of Cambridge, Ohio, and several nieces, nephews, great nieces and great nephews.

Proceeding him in death are 4 brothers; Emmitt, Warne, Robert and Richard Bennett, and 1 sister; Martha Bennett McCracken.

Visitation will be on Tuesday, April 1, 2003, from 2 to 4 and 7 to 9pm. The

service will be on Wednesday, April 2, 2003 at 11:00am, with Pastor Mick Foster. Burial will follow at Northwood Cemetery.
