Harold H. Davis, 83 of Cambridge, Ohio passed away Wednesday Nov. 21, 2007 at the S.E.O.R.M.C., he was born May 24, 1924 in Cambridge to the late Arthur and Ethel Nicholson Davis. Also preceding him in death was 3 Brothers and 4 Sisters. Harold was a contractor for Harold H. Davis Construction Company, he was a member of 9th Street United Church for 60 years. He was a WWII veteran in the European Theater, 44th Infantry Division. Harold was emeritus member of the Guernsey Co.
