Harold Lee Adams, age 65 of Kimbolton, died Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at the Ohio State University Medical Center in Columbus. He was born on January 10, 1943 in North Salem, Ohio, son of the late Gail Martin Adams and Hazel Rollstin Adams Durben.
