Harry H. Knauf, age 78, of Cambridge, passed away on Sunday, November, 27, 2016 at OSU Medical Center. He was born on February 28, 1938 in Canfield, a son of the late Willard N. Knauf and Mildred L. (Shears) Knauf. Harry was a 1956 graduate of Canfield High School. He then went Youngstown State College where he received his Bachelors in Business.
