



Henry Blair Stewart

October 2, 1917 - March 7, 2012

Henry Blair Stewart, 94, of Cambridge passed away at 3:30 AM on Wednesday March 7, 2012 at his residence at Cardinal House in Cambridge, OH. Blair was born on October 2, 1917, in Cambridge to John Edgar and Jesse Florence (Hunt) Stewart. He married Edith Byrdell (Marling) on April 5, 1941 and she survives at Cardinal House. Blair was devoted to God, family, friends, and country.

Surviving are sons: Gary (Ann) Stewart, Findlay, OH; Gene Stewart, Cambridge; Glen (Mary Lou) Stewart, Elkin, N.C; daughter Elaine (Jack) Thompson, Akron, OH. Blair was a 1936 graduate of Cambridge H.S. He was Sergeant in the U.S.Army during W.W.II, where he served from October 1940 to February 1946. Following the war he returned to Cambridge and worked as a glass cutter for Cambridge Glass and many years as a skilled electrician. He was always eager to help someone who was in need.
