August 12, 1917 - April 7, 2008

Herald L. Helmick, age 90 of Cambridge, OH., died Monday, April 7, 2008 at the Victorian Oaks Care Center. He was born August 12, 1917 in Big Flint, W.VA., son of the late Emory Clyde Helmick and Kathleen B. Ford Helmick. He was: a teacher at Doddridge County Elementary & High Schools from 1935 to 1961; a principal from 1961 to 1968 at Byesville Meadowbrook High School, a principal at West Muskingum High School, a teacher from 1968 to 1970 at Tridelphia High School in Wheeling W.VA.; a principal from 1970 to 1976 at Glass Plant Elementary in Cambridge; then 1976 to 1981 he was a Guernsey County Elementary School Supervisor. Herald was also a member of the 9th St. United Methodist Church in Cambridge and the Retired Teachers Association.
