After a long-term illness, Hubert passed away on Sunday, September 14. He and his wife, Ruth, who recently passed away, are both formerly of Cambridge, and have lived in FL in recent years.

Hubert, son of Cecil and Mildred Robey Wilson, was born October 15, 1924, graduated from Cambridge High School, and married Ruth in August of 1946. They raised their four children in Cambridge.

Hubert served in the Army Air Corps in World War II as a B25 pilot in the South Pacific, continuing as a member of the Reserves for years afterwards. He was a Cambridge business owner, with his brother Leonard, for 30 years, in Wilson Brothers Molded Plastics. He and Ruth spent their latter years in Panama City Beach, Florida, where he was an avid fisherman and charter boat captain.

He was an elder and choir member of the First Presbyterian Church.
